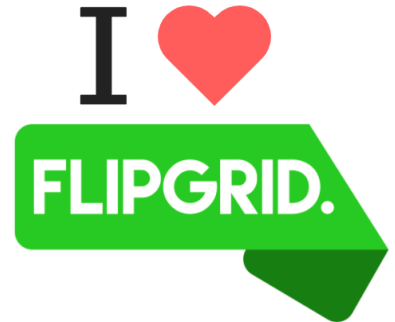

WHAT IS FLIPGRID?

FlipGrid (click here) is a **video response platform**

Students can have online video discussions with:

- Teachers
- Other students
- Classrooms across the globe

Teachers can connect with other teachers and students worldwide

Teachers can provide feedback to students

Students can provide feedback to one another



WHY USE FLIPGRID?

UDL Connections

- Video response format
- Feedback on responses
- Tool to improve fluency
- Students can respond to one another and collaborate
- Students respond using their device
- Alternative presentation format
- Connect with others around the globe
- Great for e-Learning days!

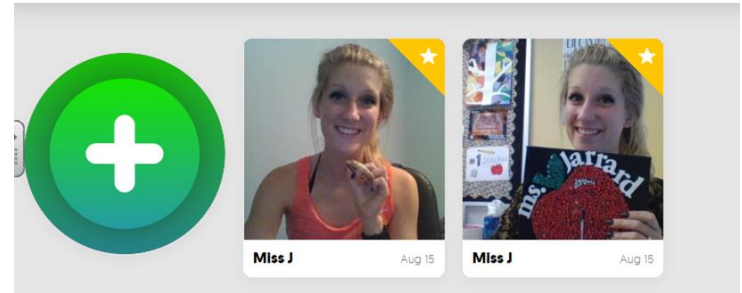
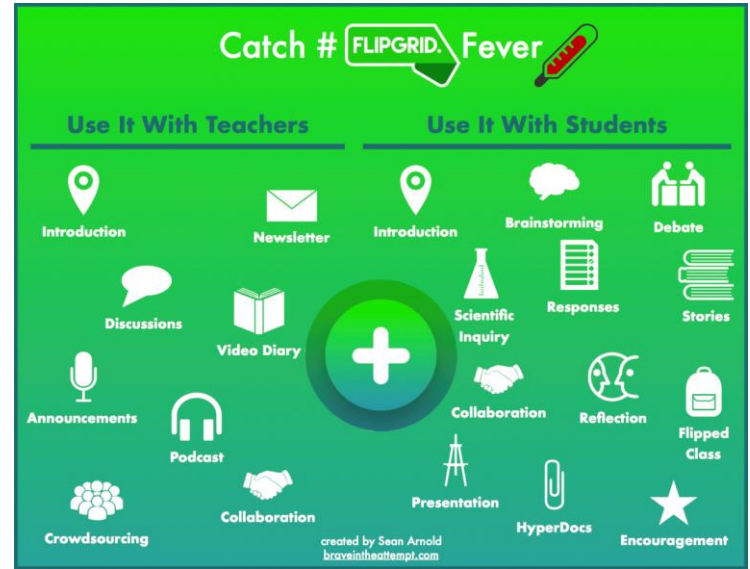

WHY DO I USE FLIPGRID?

- Give students choice in presentation
- Help students improve and document presentation skills over the school year
- Hear from the “quiet” kids
- Connect with others
- “Flip” the classroom
- Allow students to be the teachers



GETTING STARTED WITH FLIPGRID...

Sign up for an account at **flipgrid.com**

2 types of accounts:

- **FlipGrid One (Free)**
 - 1 Grid, unlimited topics, basic rubrics
- **FlipGrid Classroom (\$65/year)**
 - Unlimited grids, unlimited topics, detailed rubrics, PD opportunities

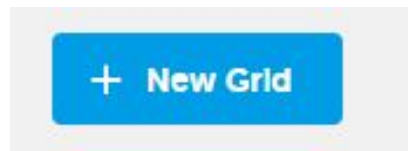
Grid: Your classroom or community of learners.

Topic: The questions or themes your students can discuss.




HOW DO YOU USE FLIPGRID?

- Create a **Grid**
- Name your grid and describe its purpose
- If you have a free account, I recommend giving your Grid a generic name so it can be used by all classes
- Adjust security settings-only those with Grid URL can access



HOW DO YOU USE FLIPGRID?

- Add “**Topics**”- themes, questions students can discuss
- At least 1 topic is required to start- this is how students make and post videos
- You have unlimited topics throughout the year- if you teach multiple classes, you can make a class topic for each class period

HOW TO USE FLIPGRID- TOPIC DETAILS

You can adjust the video response time from **15 sec-5 min**

“Response Moderation” means you must approve videos before they are visible to others

Topic Description/Question

- Where you'll write the questions, themes, or subjects students will discuss

You can insert a link in the description if you run out of characters (500 character limit)

Create a New Topic

Topics are where your learners share their videos with the community. You can create as many topics as you would like with content shared by educators from around the world!

HOW TO USE FLIPGRID- TOPIC STATUS

Active

- Students can view responses and respond

Frozen

- Students can view responses but cannot respond

Inactive

- Students cannot view responses or respond

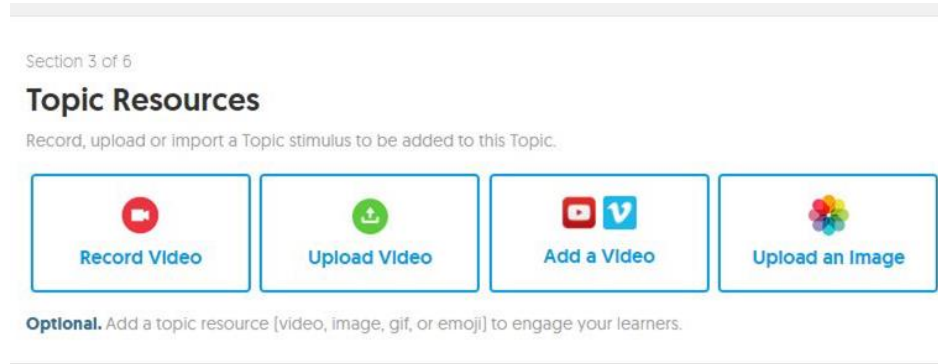
Launch and freeze dates: when the Grid is open for recording and viewing



HOW TO USE FLIPGRID- TOPIC RESOURCES

You can add:

- Your own recorded video
- Uploaded videos from your device
- Videos from YouTube and Vimeo
- Photos
- Gifs
- Emojis



Why? You can use this feature to enhance or to flip your classroom- have students view a video, examine a photo, and then respond!

HOW TO USE FLIPGRID- TOPIC ATTACHMENT

External links to items like:

- Google Docs
- Google Slides
- DropBox
- OneNote

This is where you can insert rubrics, additional questions, or resources students can review before posting their video response



HOW TO USE FLIPGRID- RESPONSE FEATURES

Response Features

- Control replies and reactions to videos

Replies to Responses

- “On” allows students to reply to one another’s videos

Response Reactions

- Students can like, use emojis, or not respond

Response Link

- Students can add links to their videos (such as their own Google Docs, Slides, etc.)

Section 5 of 6.

Response Features

Selfie Decorations

Allow students to decorate their selfies with drawings and stickers. Decorations can be individually selected or disabled entirely.

Stickers and Drawings

Response Reactions

Allow students to leave emoji reactions on a response.

Emoji Reactions



HOW TO USE FLIPGRID- TOPIC FEEDBACK

Basic Feedback

- Assess only upon Performance and Ideas- cannot be customized; only type of feedback available to FlipGrid One (free account)

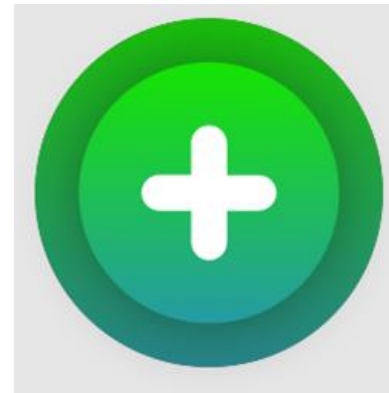
Custom Feedback

- Create your own rubrics to be used; only available for paid FlipGrid Classroom accounts



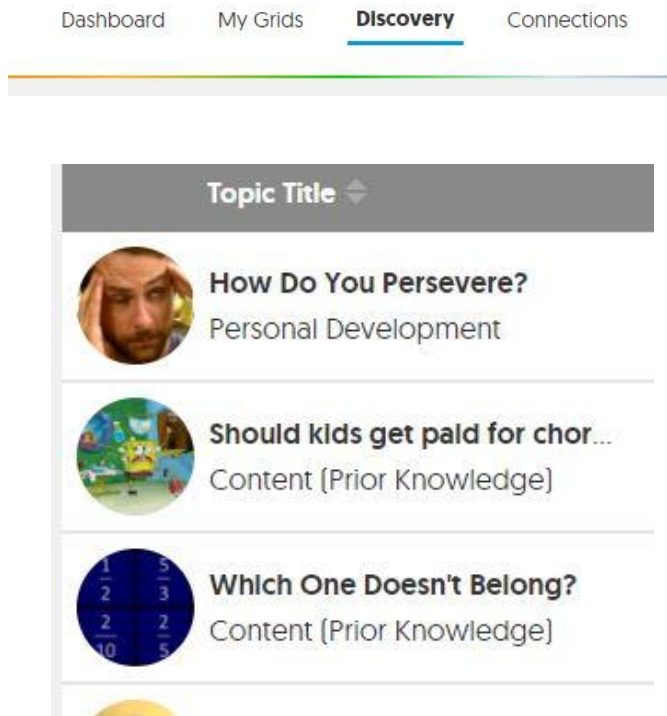
HOW CAN STUDENTS RESPOND ON FLIPGRID?

- Share code or link with students
- To create a video response, click the green “plus” button
- Discussion questions will appear to the right of video
- You can pause as many times as you like when recording
- When finished, you can add stickers, a selfie cover photo
- You do not need an email to respond!



HOW CAN I CONNECT WITH OTHERS ON FLIPGRID?

- The “Discovery” tab across the banner is where you visit the “Topic Discovery Library”
- Thousands of grids and topics already created by educators and students across the globe
 - You can add your own!
- Anyone can participate in the grid- they are not private
- Topics include current event issues and PD
- This is one way you can connect with others worldwide!



HOW CAN I CONNECT WITH OTHERS ON FLIPGRID?

- The “**Connections**” tab across your banner is where you can make global connections with schools and classrooms

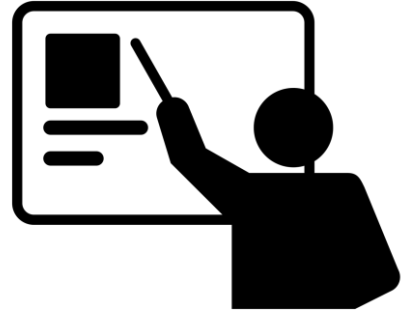

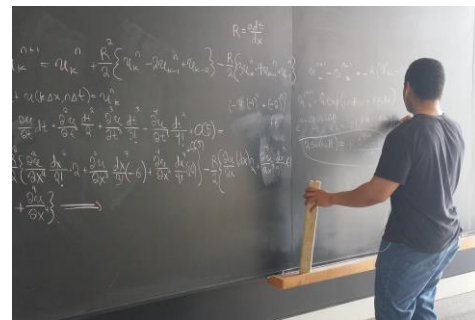
HOW CAN I USE FLIPGRID IN MY CLASSROOM?

- Classroom Introductions
- Digital reading responses
- Exit tickets
- Choice Board Option
- Alternative project presentation format
- End of class/lesson/semester reflection
- Advice to next year's class
- Debate



HOW CAN I USE FLIPGRID IN MY CLASSROOM?

- Flipped classroom- students watch video for HW and respond
- Student reflection on a lesson or unit
- Book talks
- Number talks and showing how to solve a problem
- Brainstorming project ideas
- Biography Reports (Become the character!)
- Digital “Pen Pals” with classes across the globe
