

Joe Loftus, Lobbyist for IAACE, Reported on legislation for the 2022 session.

House Bill 1118 did not get a hearing for expanding the High School Pilot Program. However, there are legislators who are interested in hearing about this in the long session next year. Priorities will be to restore full funding for Adult Education in the next session. Members need to educate legislators outside of active legislative sessions. Joe encourages us to get to know your legislatures and let them know and visit your programs. Joe also encourages IAACE members is to get to know your local businesses and Chamber and have them realize that your program are problem-solvers for them.

Christy McIntyre-Gray comments that our funding has been flat-lined for 10 years which does not correlate with our national status as adult education programs. A discussion pursued on various avenues that the Indiana surplus on the state budget (\$5 billion) can be accessed for adult education.
