#### An Idea to Increase Enrollments

Friday, September 15, 2023 marks the beginning of Hispanic Heritage Month (September 15-October 15). Hispanic Heritage Month actually began as Hispanic Heritage *Week* through a law signed by President Lyndon Johnson in 1968. Then in 1988, the observance was extended to a full month in a law signed by President Ronald Reagan in 1988. The start date of September 15 was chosen because it coincides with the anniversary of independence of Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. So what does this observance have to do with increasing adult education enrollments?

- We might be on the lookout for events in our communities that will be held observe Hispanic Heritage Month and have a presence there with adult education information.
- Secondly, if there are no events planned, consider hosting some kind of event in your adult education program that would be particularly invitational to members of the Hispanic community so they can learn about the services you can offer them.
- Thirdly, in visible places in our facilities, we can publicly recognize noteworthy people and historical events that are important to the Hispanic community. (For example, did you know that 61 people of Hispanic heritage have been awarded the Medal of Honor?)
- Fourthly, although our curricular materials should always represent people of diverse backgrounds throughout the year, during this month we might pay particular attention to make sure we have lessons that highlight the contributions of Hispanic Americans.

In all those ways, and many more, we can make our adult education programs invitational to members of the Hispanic community, especially during this month.

#### Mid-Year Performance Incentive

The Mid-Year Performance Incentive is additional money your program can earn for achieving one or two performance measures by December 31, 2023. Those performance measures are:

- Have 60% of your total year enrollment goal by December 31, 2023. (For example, if your program's enrollment goal is 200 students, 60% would be 120 students.)
- Have 57% of your students with measurable skill gains by December 31, 2023 (Table 4, Column J).

If any of this is confusing or unclear as a new director, we're here to help! Contact any of the adult education staff, your own program's Professional Development Facilitator, or me. We will be happy to explain what these goals mean and brainstorm some strategies to achieve them. It's also important to communicate those mid-year goals to your staff and your program's progress toward them regularly.

If you can't attend the meeting being held in your Region, you may attend a meeting held in any other Region. And if you didn't get it all the first time, you may attend as many of them as you'd like!
